 - Review of TIR-2010-06. C. Curcija reported no progress on this TIR requested by Lucas Turner of HTL. Tabled till next call.
- New Business:
 - Review of TIR-2011-03 Dual Entry Doors. The TIR, as written, cannot be modeled for how do we determine "significant overlap" of the two doors. It was decided to table this TIR till next call. J. Baker will meet with requestor of this TIR to discuss options and solutions.
 - Review of TIR-2011-04 Skylights in CMAST. This TIR was approved by TIPPC, but was slightly amended for clarification.

 - Review of TI-2004-06 to be rolled into the 2010 TI Manual. This TI addressed the sizing of stiles/rails with different panel/embossment sizes. NFRC staff reported that this TI was intended as part of the initial roll-in to the 2010 TI Manual but was overlooked. Therefore, it is proposed to roll the TI into the 2010 TI Manual as TI-2010-26.
