Uploading large simulation spreadsheets

This version of the CPD provides simulation laboratories the ability to upload spreadsheets up to 35MB in size in an efficient timeframe. To support the user, a progress bar will now be displayed that monitors the upload percentage and registration of the report to the server.

Recertification and archiving of large product lines

Modifications have been to the application for Inspection Agencies to process large product lines for recertification and archiving in an efficient manner.

New public search web server

A new web server has been installed; therefore, the public search provides the current rating values upon authorization of certification for a product line. The processing and displaying of the values has also been increased.
