Revision of ENERGY STAR Criteria



- DOE is revising the ENERGY STAR qualification criteria for windows, doors and skylights
- Formal process began in fall 2007
- DOE held stakeholder meeting in August 2008
- DOE extended the public comment period to November 14 at industry request
- Final criteria to be announced in early 2009
- Earliest effective date for new criteria – October 2009

Current Elements



- Two phases: 2009 and 2013
- Six climate zones, dropping to five in Phase 2
- Minimum Energy Performance (MEP) criteria in the two northern zones
- Trade-offs in South under review
- IGU certification requirement to go into effect when implemented by NFRC
- Separate criteria for swinging entry doors

Two-Phase Approach

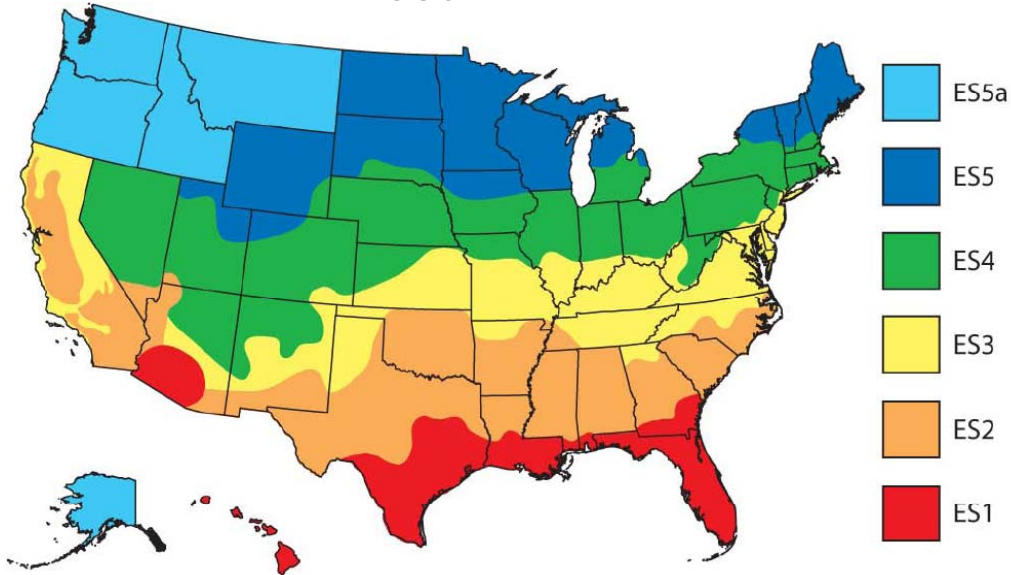


Phase 1	2009	Modest & feasible incremental changes to re-establish leadership and differentiation
Phase 2	2013	Aggressive targets to move industry to advanced technologies and new platforms

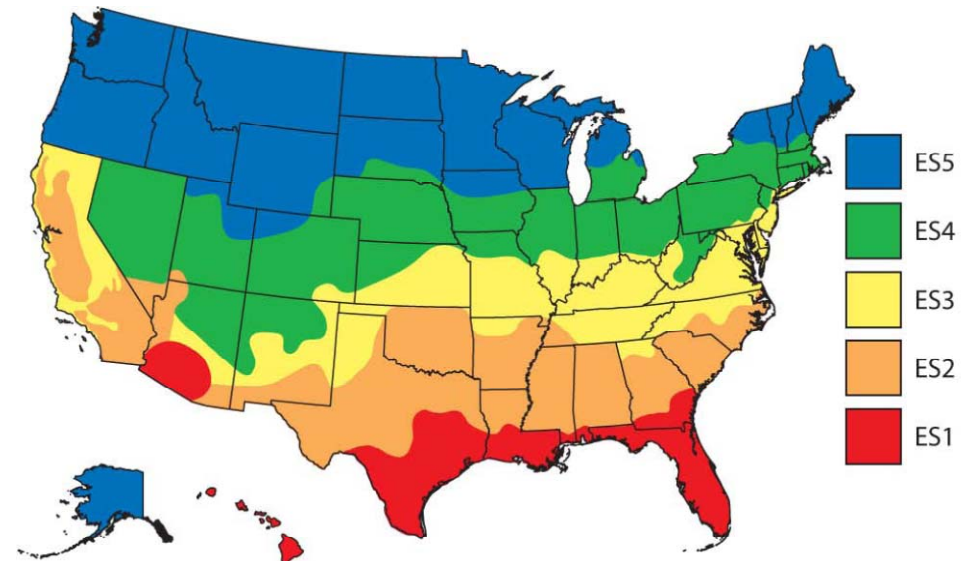
Proposed ENERGY STAR Climate Zone Map

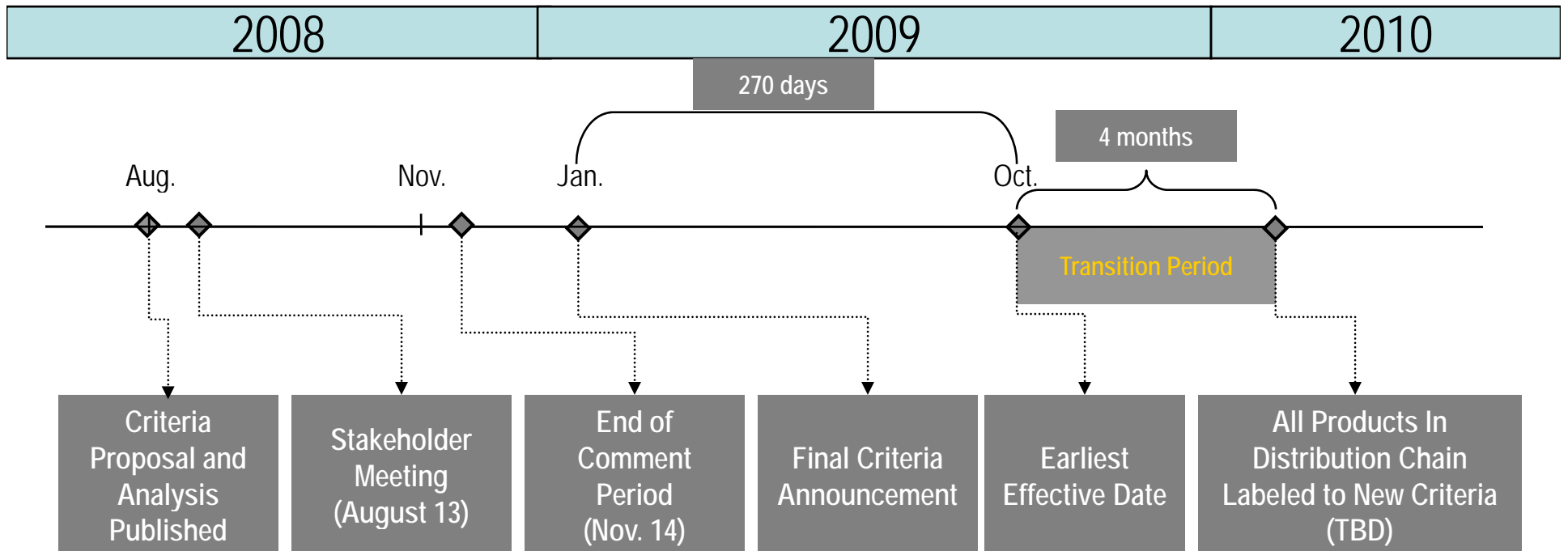
