SUBJECT: Labeling of blinds / dynamic options; and Information on NFRC IG Certification

This bulletin relates to the labeling products with blinds between the glass and information regarding the NFRC Certification Insulating Glass Program.

Item 1: Blinds between the Glass

The CPC has determined that products containing blinds between the glass shall be rated using a dynamic label.

In accordance with the NFRC Board of Directors approval, labeling options with blinds between the glass shall be mandatory 6 months after the release of Window 6 or March 1, 2010, which ever comes first.

Item 2: IG Certification required July 1, 2010

The NFRC encourages all participants in the NFRC Certification Program to prepare for the new NFRC IG Certification Program. Please view the IG Certification web page for further information: <http://www.nfrc.org/IGCertification.aspx>

NFRC IG Certification will be required for all PCP participants on July 1, 2010.

NOTE: For participants who have products lines certified prior to July 1, 2010, IG Certification is required for those product lines by the mandatory certification date.
