Item 1: Publication and Implementation of NFRC 706-2011 E0A2

The NFRC Board has approved NFRC 706-2011 E0A2, which is published and implemented and is available on the NFRC Website.

- **Summary of the NFRC 706 Board approved changes:**
 - **New Technologies:**
 - **New language was developed for the IG Certification Program (IGC) to bring forth extension requests for IG products considered new technologies which are not governed in the CGSB 12.8 and ASTM E2190-10 specifications.**
 - **Air space materials:**
 - **Language was developed regarding the testing of internal components requiring certified insulating glass test samples which shall include the air space materials.**

Item 2: Publication and Implementation of New Technologies IG Extension Request Form

The NFRC Board has approved the use of the NFRC New Technologies IG

Extension Request Form, which is published and is available on the NFRC Website and developed specifically to be used by the Insulated Glazing Certification Programs.

Based on the modifications to the “Duties of the IGC” in section 1.2 of the NFRC 706: “New technologies shall be evaluated by the participating IGC Entity regarding certification within the Participating IGC Program. In the event that the Participating IGC Program cannot certify or provide any temporary certification for a new technology, the participating IGC Entity shall be the responsible party for providing justification and requesting a compliance extension for their client(s).”
